Day Center Services

KentHOPE welcomes women (with or without children) into a warm, safe, and loving environment. We support our guests by building relationships and providing services, including:

- Direct intake into shelter services
- Clothing, shoes, and hygiene items
- Meals and snacks
- Case management
- Referral and resource assistance
- Housing application and job readiness assistance
- Mail service, bus tickets, phone and computer access
- Bible studies, devotions, and weekly classes
- Access to medical and mental health providers

Other Mission Programs

For women with or without children

Our Women and Children's Shelter in Seattle helps stabilize women who are struggling with homelessness. We help women struggling with trauma, abuse, addiction, mental health issues, medical conditions, job loss, and more.

Our Extended Care Program at Hope Place in Seattle offers impactful care to women coming out of the hospital who need a safe place to stay, with medical treatment, but have nowhere to go.

Our Recovery Program at Hope Place in Seattle is a 12-month residential recovery program designed to help women break free from destructive behaviors and relationships through the power of Jesus Christ. We emphasize a skills-based and relational approach to healing.

Our Link Program at KentHOPE is a clean and sober residential program designed to help women seek and maintain employment or education. While in the program, they are able to save funds for stable housing, receive Christian discipleship, case management, life skills, and more.
