The Enhanced Shelter program for women and children gives guests the comfort of knowing they have a safe, warm bed to sleep in each night, a secure place for their belongings, and a case manager to walk with them on their journey to a new life. Our enhanced shelter offers women the opportunity to begin to stabilize and address the barriers in their lives that keep them on the streets. Our team also has more time to work with individuals and let them know how much they are loved by God and us, no matter their circumstances.

We meet our homeless neighbors' basic needs by providing a warm, clean bed, nutritious meals, hygiene items, hot showers, clothing, and other services, including legal and dental. We also offer:

- Case management to provide accountability, to help our guests make and achieve goals, and to help them address the issues that have kept them on the streets.
- Counseling, mentoring, devotions, and Bible studies to help our guests grow healthy relationships with God and other people.
- Pathways to other Mission programs for women that focus on long term recovery, education and career development and permanent housing.
- Connections to outside resources as needed, including employment assistance, housing assistance, health services, and more.
